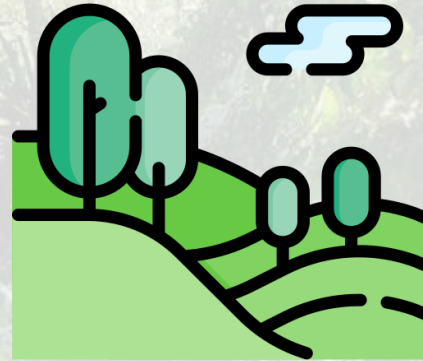


# A Guide for Growing Yellow Ginger

## Selecting Land

[1]

**Select hilly or sloped areas and avoid swampy and flat ground.**



[2]

**Select land with loose black soil to help yellow ginger multiply.**



## Selecting & Preparing Land

[4]



**Chose an area with trees that give some shade.**

[3]



**Pick an area with plants and trees, but avoid planting next to tree roots.  
See Planting List.**

[5]



**Do not do slash-and-burn (milpa) in the selected area.**



# Planting

[7]



Plant each turmeric root below the ground, 1 to 4 inches deep.

[6]



Plant at the start or end of the rainy season.

[8]



Plant the yellow ginger crops approximately 1 foot away from each other.



# Maintenance

[10]



Cut weeds and drop leaves and weeds on the ground to enrich the soil.

[9]



Do not use a machine to water your yellow ginger.

[11]



Do not use any chemicals.



# Harvesting & Cleaning

[13]



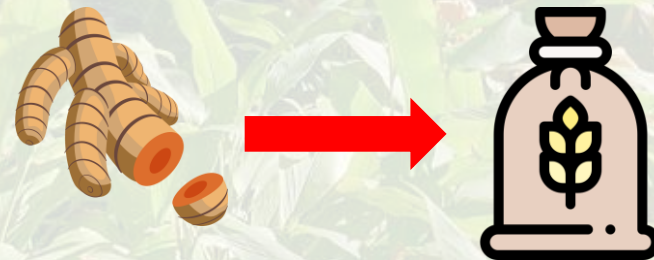
Wash yellow ginger roots in a basin, and do not put dirty water in the creeks and rivers.

[12]



Harvest yellow ginger when the leaves turn brown and the roots are orange. Keep the small roots to replant.

[14]



Deliver clean, fresh air-dried yellow ginger to Naledo's factory in a clean bag.
